

Boarders - Overseas Boys and Girls: €21,450 (EU)

The Fee is payable in advance in two half-yearly instalments

Date of payment: 1st half year – on or before 1st August 2026

2nd half year – on or before 1st November 2026

A deposit of €1,000 is payable on final confirmation of your place in the College, this amount is deducted from your statement in June annually.

In the event of cancellation the deposit is non-refundable.

Please ensure you quote your Account Reference **OR** child's name on all bank transfers to the Rockwell College account. Your Account Reference will be shown on your invoice/statement from the College.

This fee includes tuition, meals, accommodation, games and recreational facilities, supervised study, EFL classes, the cost of in-school nursing care, photocopying, postage, administration, 24 hour accident insurance cover and the school journal. It also includes retreats, team buses and mandatory subject-specific school excursions.

Discounts: 25% discount for second and subsequent siblings as per the Fee Policy conditions.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

Where Rockwell College is the Agent, an Agent Fee of €2,500 is charged (see Agent application form for details)

Reserve Fee is charged to cover the costs which will be incurred during the year.

The balance of this amount is returned to parents provided there are no fees outstanding.

If the reserve fee is insufficient to cover all charges, you will be required to forward extra funds.

The list of charges, below, is not exhaustive.

A. Where Rockwell College is the Agent: Reserve Fee €3,000

2. **Sports Gear** is available to purchase on-line at www.uniformity.ie
3. **Class books:** a list of the schoolbooks required is forwarded to all students in June. Books are not sold at the College. Books are available at Stakelum's Office Supplies, Parnell St., Thurles, AM Office Supplies, Cashel and at bookstores nationally
4. **Home Economics Charge:** Boarders taking Home Economics as a subject will be charged €100 per annum for store cupboard ingredients.
5. **Laundry:** €27 per bag charged by the College to your account (inclusive of 1 coloured & 1 white bag per trip to Laundry)
6. **Transport:** To/from bus/train stations, airports & other trips will be charged as used.
7. **Transition Year:** Estimate of costs relating to excursions and activities is €1,500. The cost of any non-mandatory trips outside of Ireland are not included in this estimate.
8. **Exam charges:** State exam charges and mock exam correction charges
9. **Medical Care:** Hospital/doctor/dentist/oculist's fees, extra-ordinary medical attention, physiotherapy, A&E, hospital charges, special nursing and medicines will be charged if and as required. Transport costs related to medical care will be charged to Parents/Guardian.



B. Where Rockwell College is NOT the Agent: Reserve Fee €1,000

Home Economics Charge: Boarders taking Home Economics as a subject will be charged €100 per annum for store cupboard ingredients.

Laundry: €27 per bag charged by the College to your account (inclusive of 1 coloured & 1 white bag per trip to Laundry)

Transport: Agents will arrange transport for their students to/from bus/train stations, airports, medical appointments etc. If, on occasion, the agent requires the College to assist with such transport, the College will assist, if possible. All transport costs will then be charged to your account, as they arise.

Excursions, weekend trips etc that the College arranges will be charged to your account.

Exam charges: State exam charges and mock exam correction charges

Medical Care: Agents will arrange medical appointments and transport their students to such appointments. If, on occasion, the agent requires the College to assist with such an appointment, the College will assist, if possible. All medical costs will then be charged to your account, as they arise.

Transition Years Only: An extra €1,500 will be charged at the beginning of the year for all agent students in Transition Year. This payment is for TY specific costs and is separate to the above additional costs.

Payment Details for Overseas Boarding Students in Rockwell College

Payment Options:

Single Payment: Due on or before August 1st, 2026

or

Two half-year payments: Due August 1st, 2026 & November 1st, 2026

The Reserve Fee & TY Charge (where applicable) must be paid in full by August 1st annually.
