Boarders - Seven Day Irish Boys and Girls: €17,928

The fee is payable in advance in two half-yearly instalments

Date of payment: 1st half year – on or before 1st August 2026

2nd half year – on or before 1st November 2026

Standing Order option can be setup on electronic banking and inform accounts@rockwellcollege.ie of same. Payments must commence August 1st 2026 and continue over 10 consecutive months up to and including May 1st 2027.

A deposit of €1,000 is payable on final confirmation of your place in the College. This amount is deducted on your statement which will issue in June annually.

In the event of cancellation the deposit is non-refundable.

Please ensure you quote your Account Reference **OR** child's name on all bank transfers to the Rockwell College account. Your Account Reference will be shown on your invoice/statement from the College.

This fee includes tuition, meals, accommodation, games and recreational facilities, supervised study, the cost of in-school nursing care, photocopying, postage, administration, 24 hour accident insurance cover and the school journal. It also includes retreats, team buses and mandatory subject-specific school excursions.

Discounts: 25% discount for second and subsequent siblings as per the Fee Policy conditions.

ADDITIONAL COSTS:

- **Uniform** - available from Helen's Kidswear online at helensuniforms@gmail.com
- **Sports Gear** – available to purchase on-line at www.uniformity.ie
- **Class books** - a list of the schoolbooks required is forwarded to all students in June. Books are not sold at the College. Books are available at Stakelum's Office Supplies, Parnell St., Thurles, AM Office Supplies, Cashel and at bookstores nationally.
- **Home Economics Charge** – Boarders taking Home Economics as a subject will be charged €100 per annum for store cupboard ingredients.
- **Laundry:** €27 per bag charged by the College to your account (inclusive of 1 coloured & 1 white bag per trip to Laundry)
- **Transport** – transport to/from bus/train stations, airports & other trips will be charged as used.
- **Transition Year** - Estimate of additional costs relating to excursions and activities is €1,500 approx. The cost of any non-mandatory trips outside of Ireland are not included in this estimate.
- **Exam charges** – state exam charges and mock exam correction charges
- **Medical Care:** Hospital/doctor/dentist/oculist fees, extra-ordinary medical attention, physiotherapy, A&E, hospital charges, special nursing and medicines will be charged if and as required. Transport costs related to medical care will be charged to Parents/Guardian.
